His primary job at the political cartoon oriented publisher The Nib has broadened his scope of dialogue in identity politics while also given him several opportunities to edit and publish comic work. His short films have been exhibited in galleries and screenings in Oregon, California, Italy, and Belgium. This is unlikely to happen.


















































































